The Start Mark for the 4.2m<sup>2</sup> fleet and the Regatta Fleet will be an orange buoy with a flagpole and orange flag.

The Finish Mark for all fleets will be an orange buoy with a flagpole and orange flag.

**Amendment No 2.**

**14 THE FINISH**

14.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying a blue flag on the committee boat and the finish mark which will be an orange buoy with a flagpole and orange flag.

**Course – Windward/Leeward.**

Start – 1 – Wing – 2 – 1 – Wing – 2 – Finish Mark. All marks rounded to Port.

**4.2 m<sup>2</sup> and Regatta Course**

Start – 1 – Wing – 2 – Finish Mark. All marks rounded to Port.
